

Holt - Kinney Woods

Mansfield, CT

Holt-Kinney Woods is a twenty-one acre parcel given to the Trust in 1996 by Hamilton and Katherine Holt in memory of her parents, Dr. Kenneth and Mrs. Claire Kinney. The preserve stretches from Browns Road on the south to the town's Schoolhouse Brook Park on the north.

The preserve is largely an young oak-hickory bisected west to east by an unnamed brook. The trail also passes through a white pine grove in an area that was once known as the Six Acre Meadow. An unusual feature is the double stone wall at the north boundary of the pine grove. Its purpose remains a mystery.

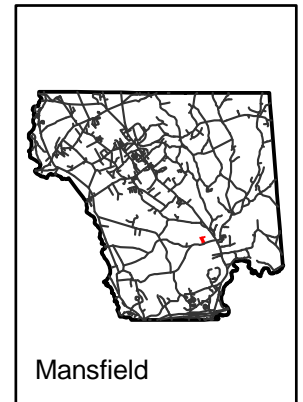
