

Owen's Mere Preserve

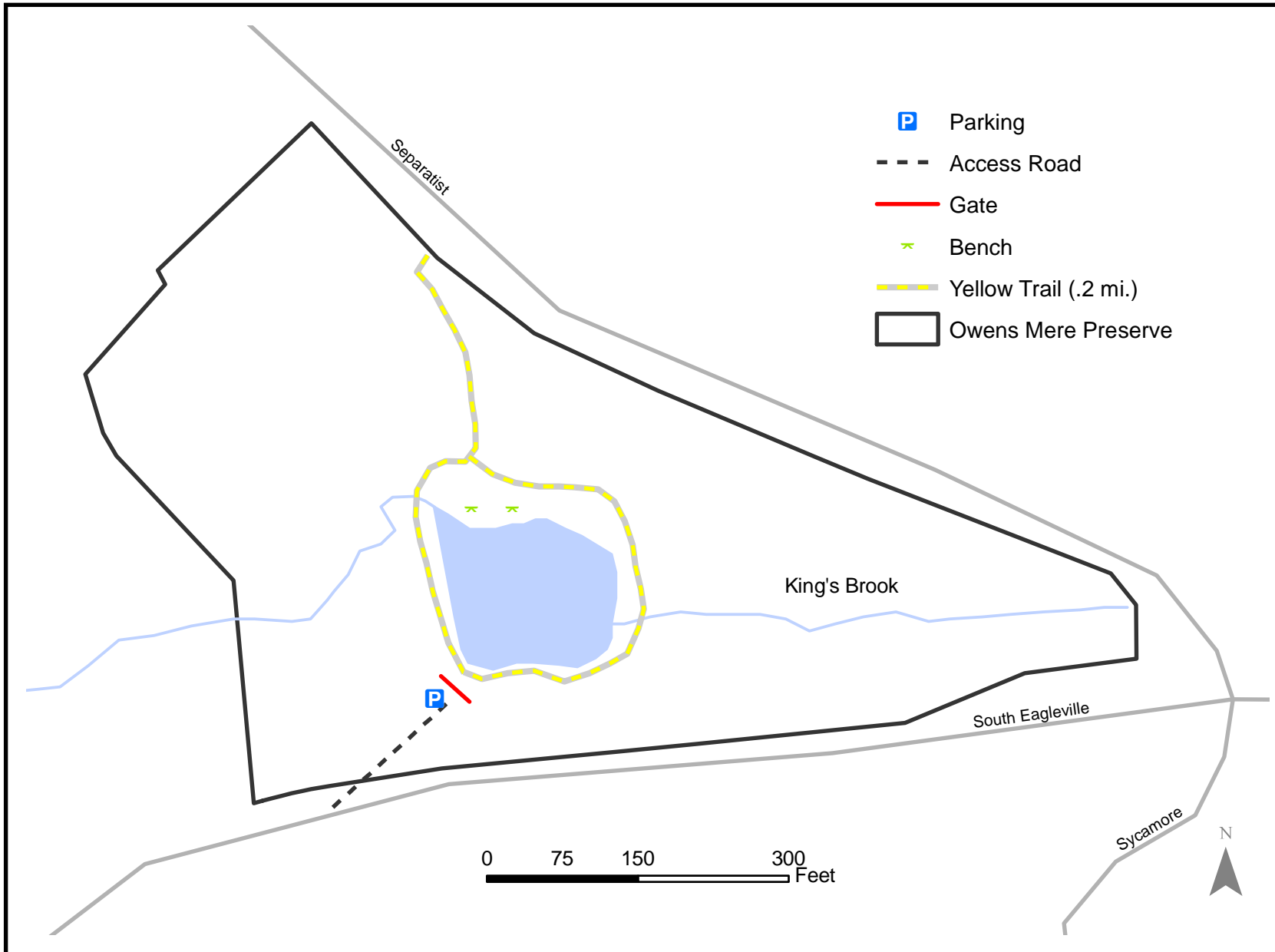
Mansfield, CT

Owen's Mere Preserve is a 9-acre parcel that was given to the Trust in 1995 by Charles and Mabel Owen. It features a half acre pond created by an earthen dam on King's Brook. The pond is both scenic and provides a small wildlife area. Two benches built for an Eagle Scout project lie in a small open area on the north side of the pond. The rest of the preserve is forested and hosts abundant spring wildflowers.

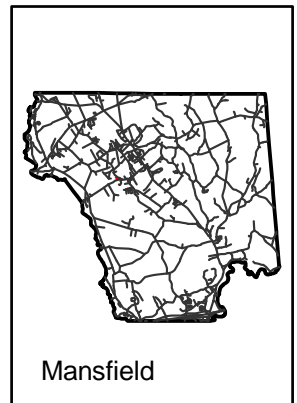
