

Pappenheimer Preserve

Scotland, CT

The Pappenheimer Preserve was donated to the Trust in 2005 by Sarah Pappenheimer and her brother John. It consists of 101 acres of mostly level forest land and marsh. The property has belonged to the family for several generations and has been used for grazing and timber cutting, both of which may continue during the lifetimes of the donors. It is bounded to the north by 700 acres of Mohegan State Forest, and so adds a significant area to this undeveloped wildlife habitat. However, visitors should be aware that the state forest is actively hunted in season, so precautions should be followed.



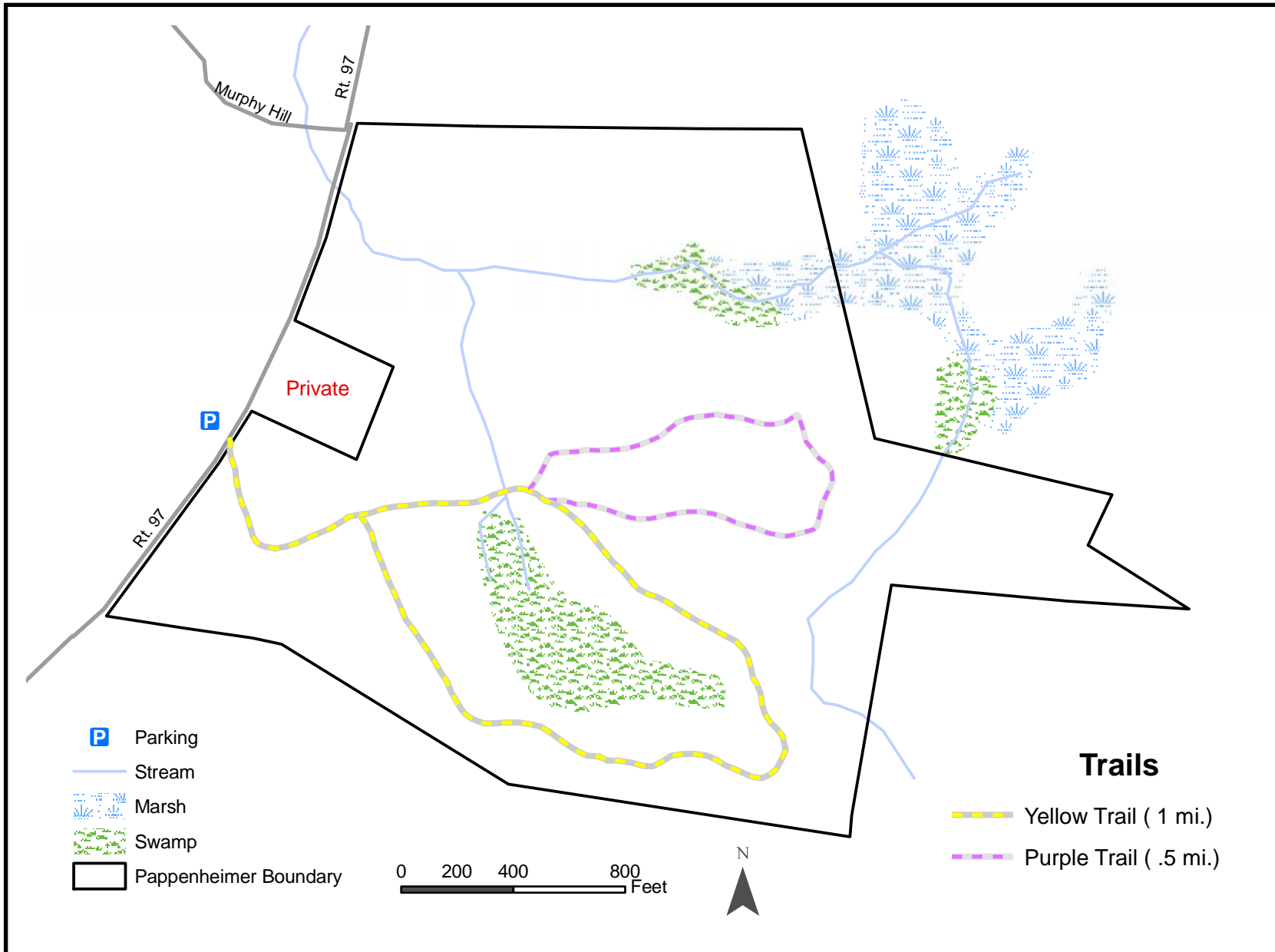
