

# Potter Meadow Preserve

Columbia, CT

Potter Meadow was given to the Trust by Whitehall Properties in 1988. It is a 34-acre parcel that lies entirely within the floodplain of the Willimantic and Ten Mile Rivers, and may be impassable after heavy rains.

Long used by the Potter family as pasture land, today it provides excellent wildlife habitat with a variety of wetland and riparian types as well as an adjacent sandy area used as a turtle nesting area.



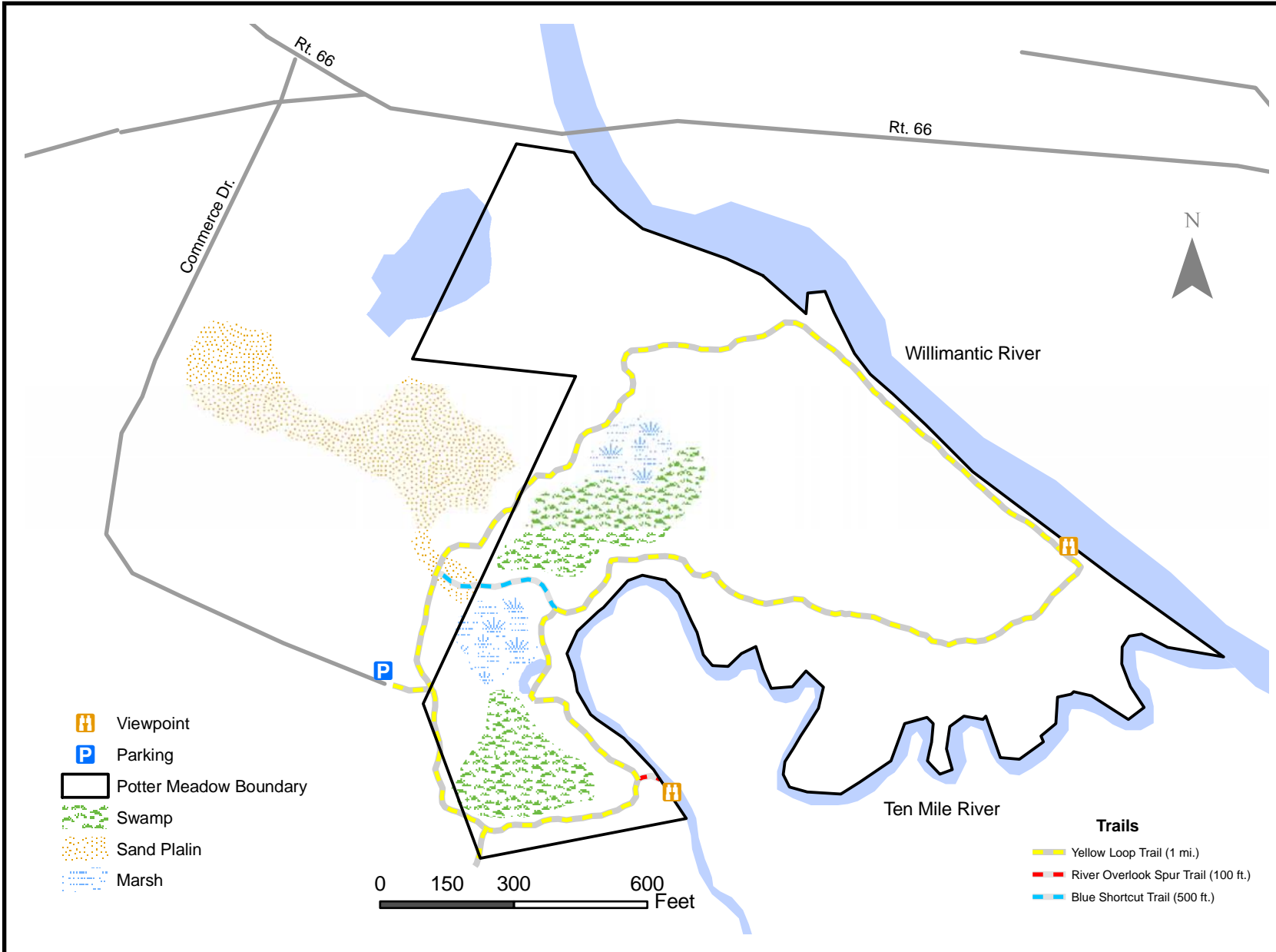

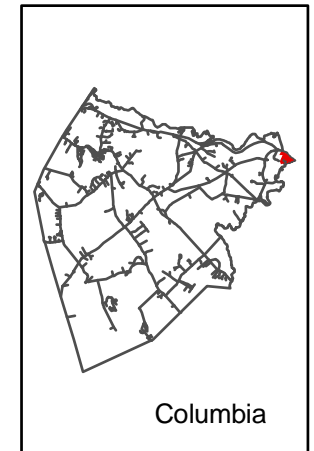
